Quinquennial - Every 5 years we are required to have a survey carried out to ensure we keep the church and property in good repair. The report is extensive and will be available within a couple of months. I did have a conversation with the architect about the church lighting. You may have noticed (if you are eagle eyed or bored during the homily!) that the light bulbs are slowly going, we are now up to 6 and these bulbs are obsolete. It should be possible to only replace the light fittings, dependent on the quality of the wiring. Replacing the fittings will also enable us to have a more energy efficient lighting system. I will seek to get this completed in due time, with as least disruption as possible.
