

IMPORTANT: COVID-19 Safety Update St John the Baptist Alton, April 2021.

As you all know we are all pleased Places of Worship can remain open; however, it is extremely important that we remain meticulous with our face coverings, hand hygiene and social distancing to ensure everyone remains safe. If a parish is found not to be complying with the rules they could be forced to cease public worship.

The legislation that we have to follow in order to open Church will be in place until at least 21st June. The fact that some people have been vaccinated or have recently had a negative test does not mean that the guidelines do not need to be followed.

Please listen to stewards' instructions and follow signs in place. The stewards know how to make most efficient and safest use of the seating available in our small church in order to fit in safely the maximum permitted congregation. Please sit where the stewards indicate. This may not be your favourite bench! Thank you for your understanding.

Please make certain that your face covering is in place before entering the church itself where you will find hand sanitiser in the porch. Contact details must be provided in the book or with a steward. Please maintain Social Distancing at all times.

Currently people can only sit in the same pew as members of the same household/support bubble, OR, if advised by the steward 2 individuals can sit at opposite ends of the larger benches with space between them. (1 metre plus with face covering).

Please be reminded that you "must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble" whilst in church.

Please leave at the end of Mass as soon as you have finished prayer. Please do not congregate in the cloister or doorways. Always follow the one way system, please do not backtrack along the cloister. If you are in the cloister and need to go back into church please exit and go around to the front entrance.

As numbers attending Mass continue to increase we may need to start regular bookings for the Saturday night & Sunday morning masses. Please read the newsletter each week to check for updates. The Sunday evening mass (resumes on 18th April) is not crowded and all are welcome.

Please DO NOT attend Church if you or, or someone in your household, has: Tested positive for Covid, or have been tested and are awaiting results, or, have a high temperature or new, continuous cough or loss, or change, to your sense of taste or smell. You must stay at home.
